This is a very important update concerning the 303 West project. Please share as much as possible. Yesterday we reported that 303 would not be completely closed at the bypass and the bowl. That has changed. Due to weather delays from the wonderful spring we have had the project has had to be amended and the schedule altered. Beginning on Monday, April 16, 2018, 303 WILL BE COMPLETELY closed at the BYPASS and the BOWL for a period of two weeks. During this time the bypass road will be upgraded to accommodate traffic during the rest of the project and they will also begin digging out the bowl in preparation for the permanent repair of the bowl area. The bypass road will be reopened as soon as they can get the upgrades completed. The project is on a very tight schedule that needs to be completed by October 31st to keep from going in to the winter months. This has necessitated the change in scheduling and the change in the closing of the road completely. We have been assured that emergency vehicle traffic including Police, Fire and EMS will have 100% access during the closure but all other traffic will be prohibited during this time and response times of emergency vehicles will be not be delayed. The folks in Lakeside Terrace, Hickory Ridge and points west may still use the Jefferson to Mondial to 14 route to access your shopping and other needs. I realize this is different than what we originally posted but it is beyond any of our control. The only other scheduled closing is as we stated yesterday, around July 1st 303 will be closed from Jefferson to the tracks for the culvert replacement this will be for about 30 days. Our Fire Department and Police Department will make the necessary arrangements with Hudson to ensure that Fire, Police and EMS will not be delayed beyond the tracks. We apologize for this last minute change and hope that we can get the word out to our residents and travelling public. Thank you for your understanding as we complete this very important project.
